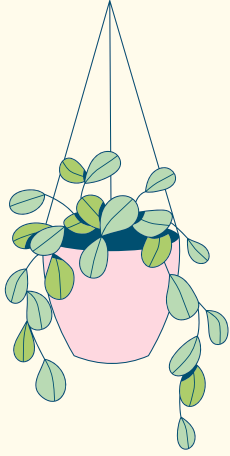
Importance of Greetings

- Proper greetings help establish a positive interaction and build relationships.



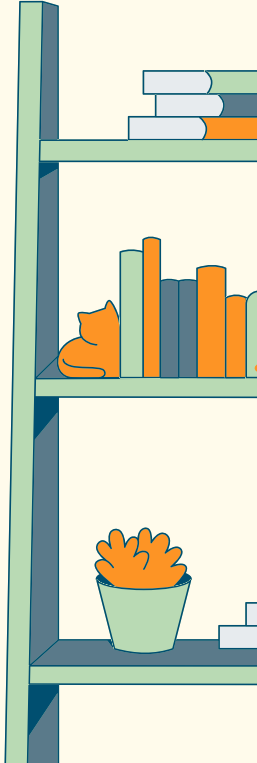
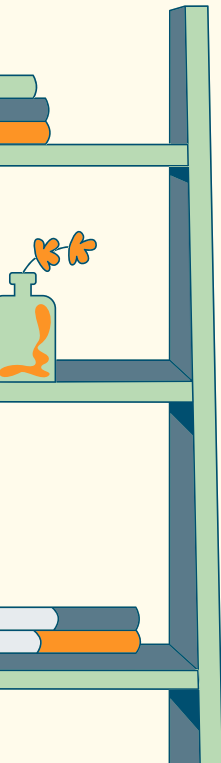
Basic Greetings

1. "Hallo" - Hello
2. "Guten Morgen" - Good morning
3. "Guten Tag" - Good day / Good afternoon
4. "Guten Abend" - Good evening
5. "Gute Nacht" - Good night



Formal Greetings

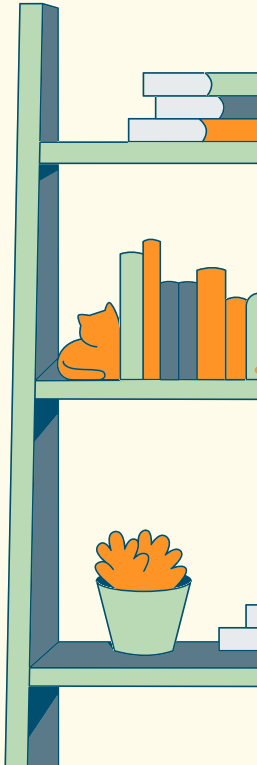
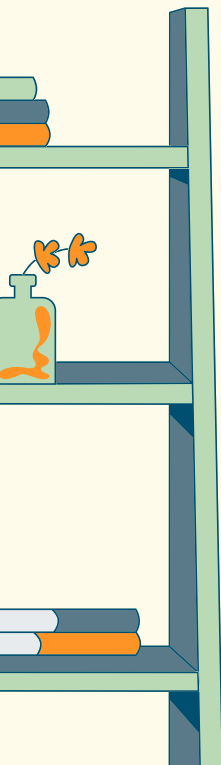
- "Guten Tag" - Good day / Good afternoon (formal)
- "Guten Morgen / Guten Abend" - Good morning / Good evening (formal)
- "Wie geht es Ihnen?" - How are you? (formal)
- "Es freut mich, Sie kennenzulernen." - Nice to meet you. (formal)





• Informal • Greetings

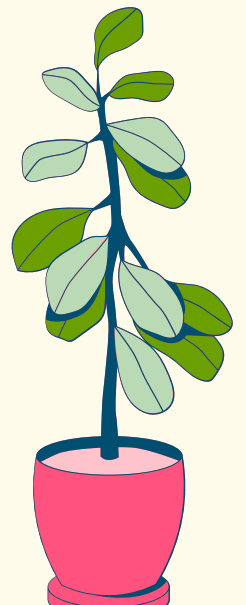
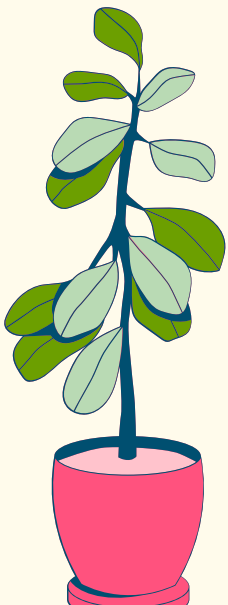
- ""Hallo" - Hello (informal)
- "Moin" - Hi (used in northern Germany)
- "Servus" - Hi / Bye (used in southern Germany and Austria)
- "Wie geht's?" - How are you? (informal)

2. "Tschüss" - Bye (informal)
3. "Bis später" - See you later
4. "Mach's gut" - Take care
