It helps in avoiding wordiness and makes communication more effective. One-word substitutions are commonly used in formal writing to convey meaning precisely.

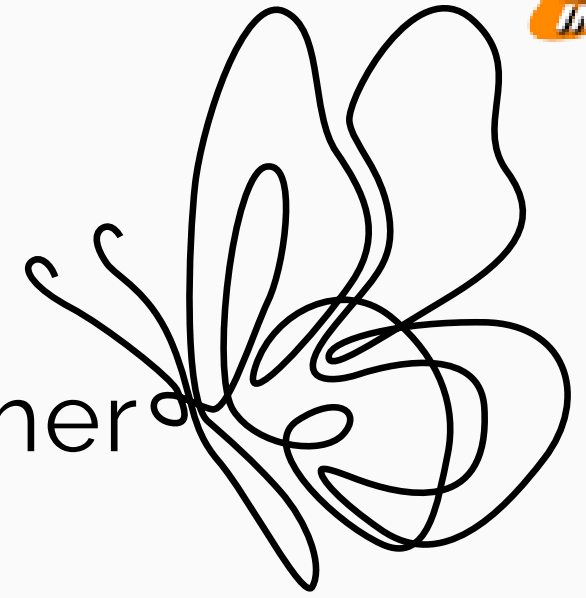
