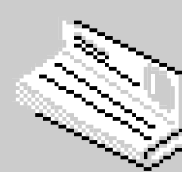
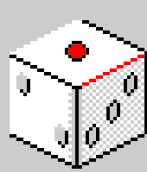
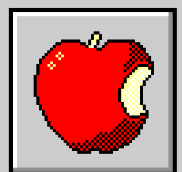


## Pyplot

- It is the overall window or page on which everything is drawn.

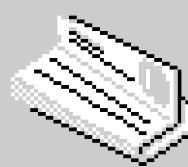
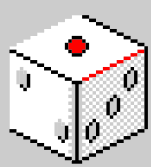
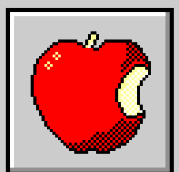

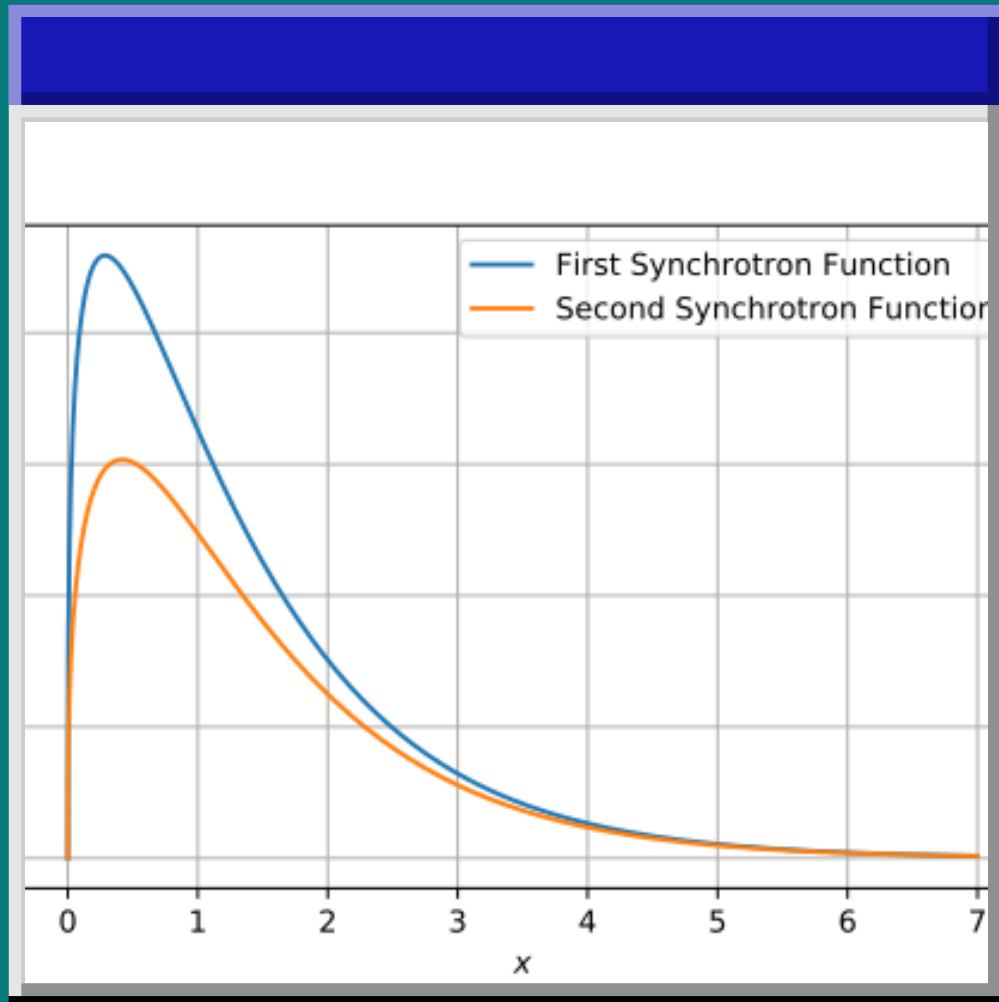


## Axes

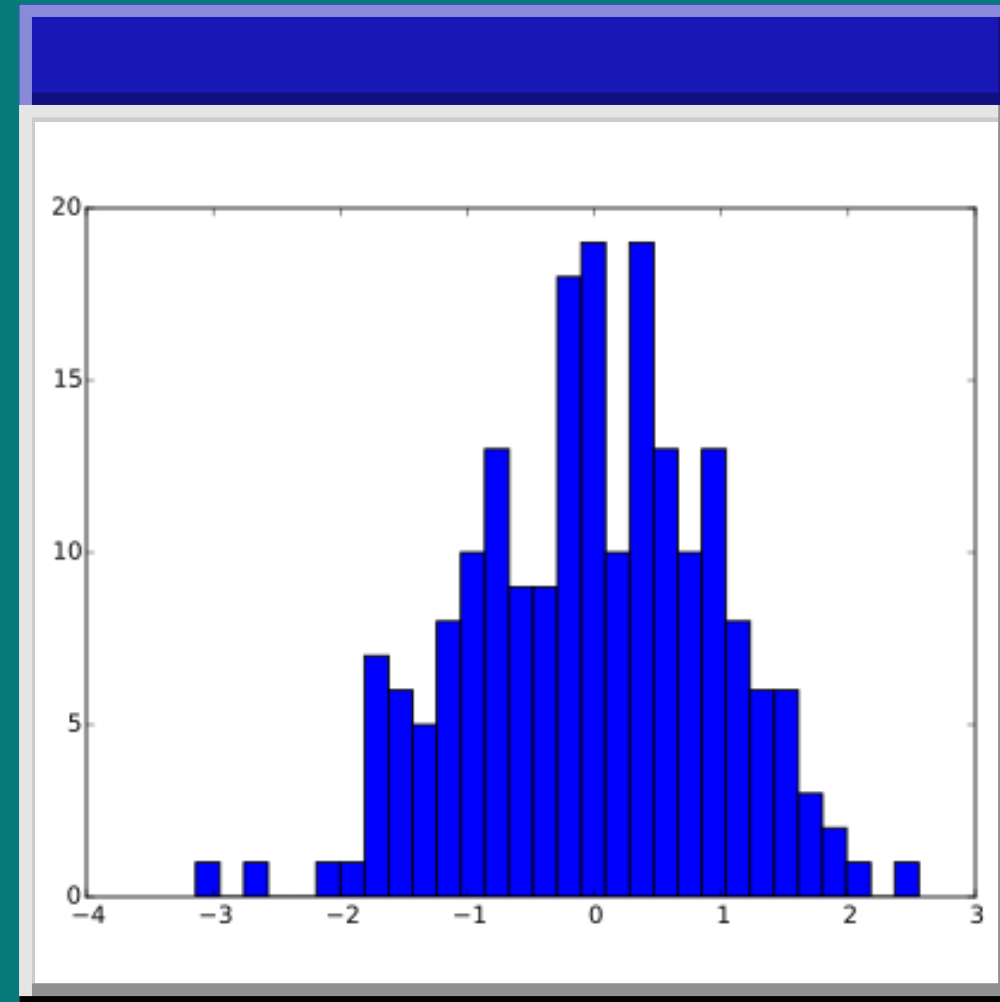
- Axis used for creating sub-plots

- A given figure may contain many axes.



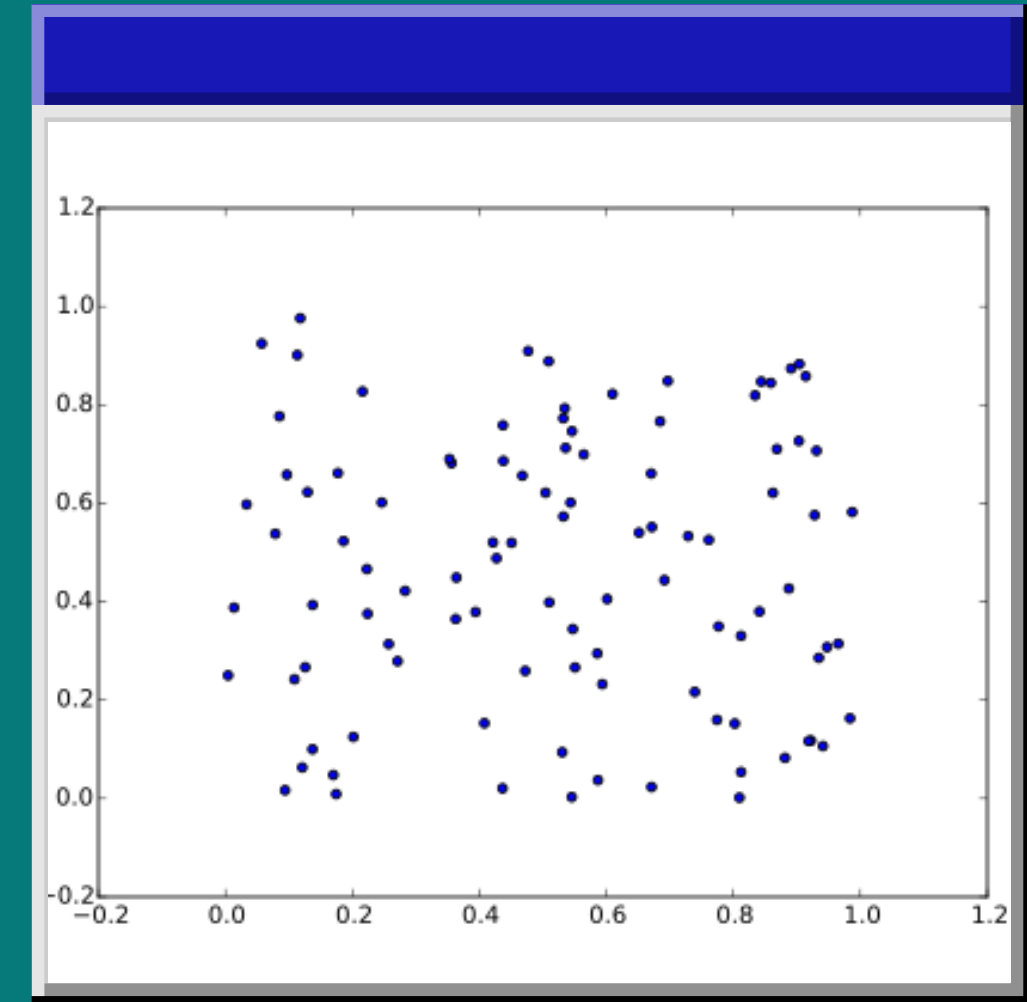
