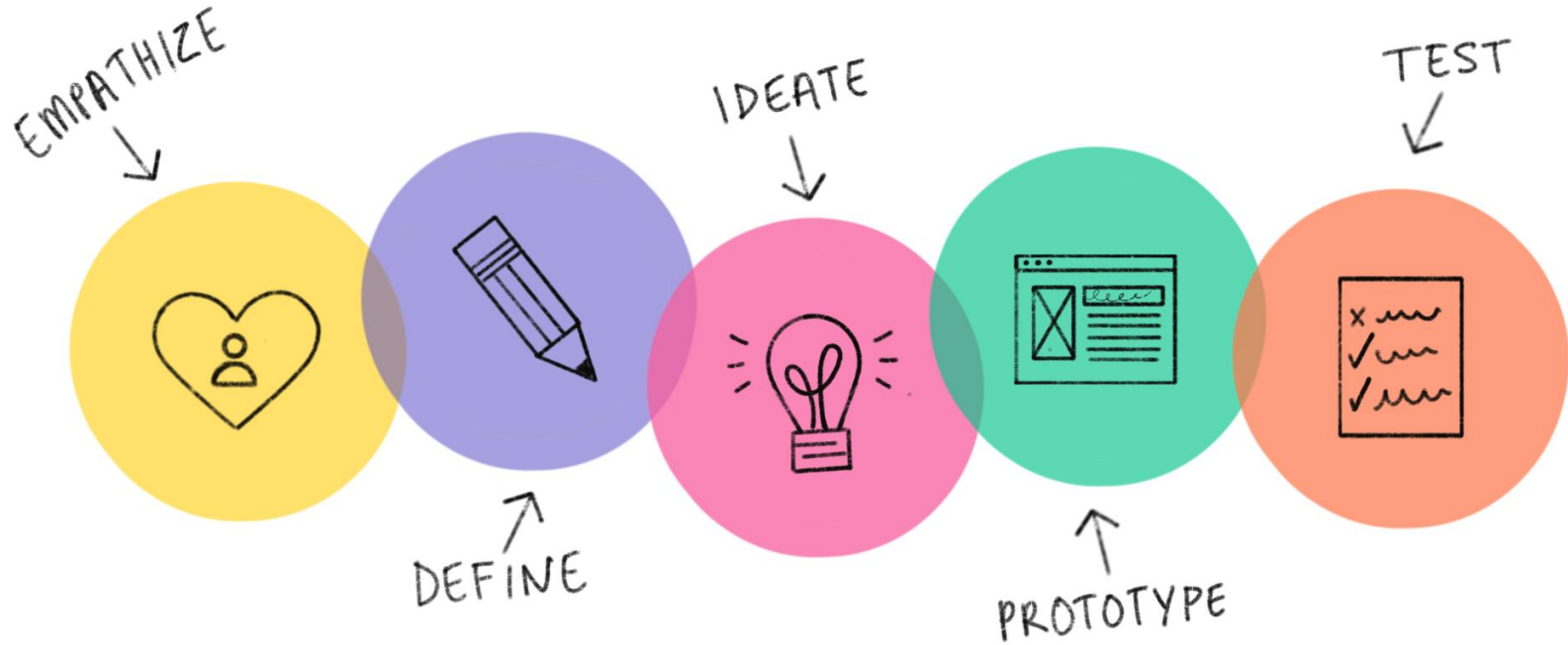

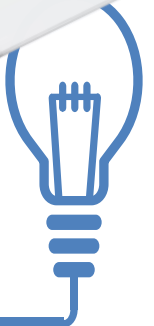
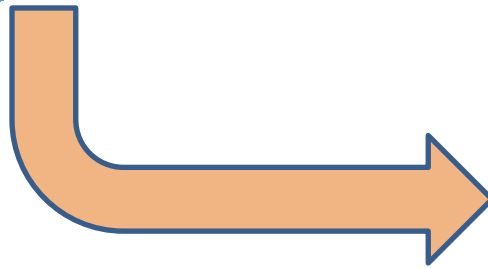


Whittington hospital in UK has faced the problem of handling the crowd.

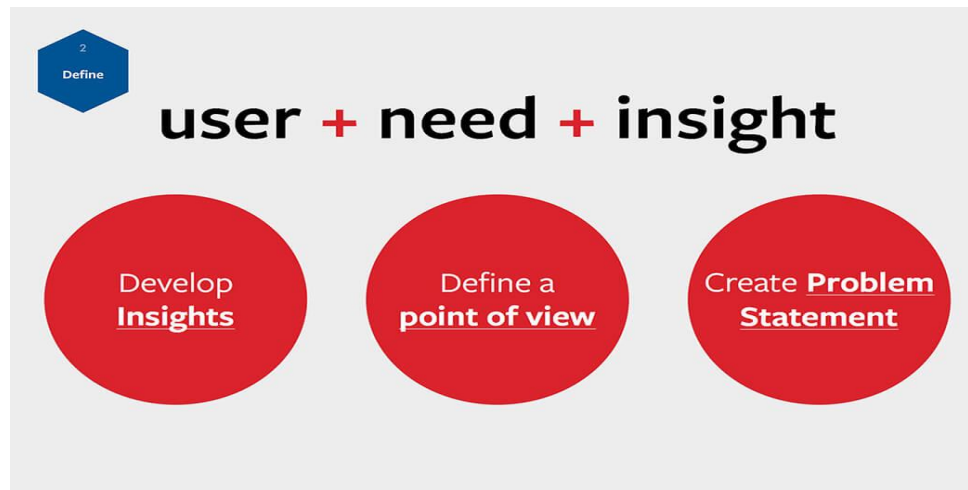
Define

To see the results from anywhere without going to the hospital unnecessarily.

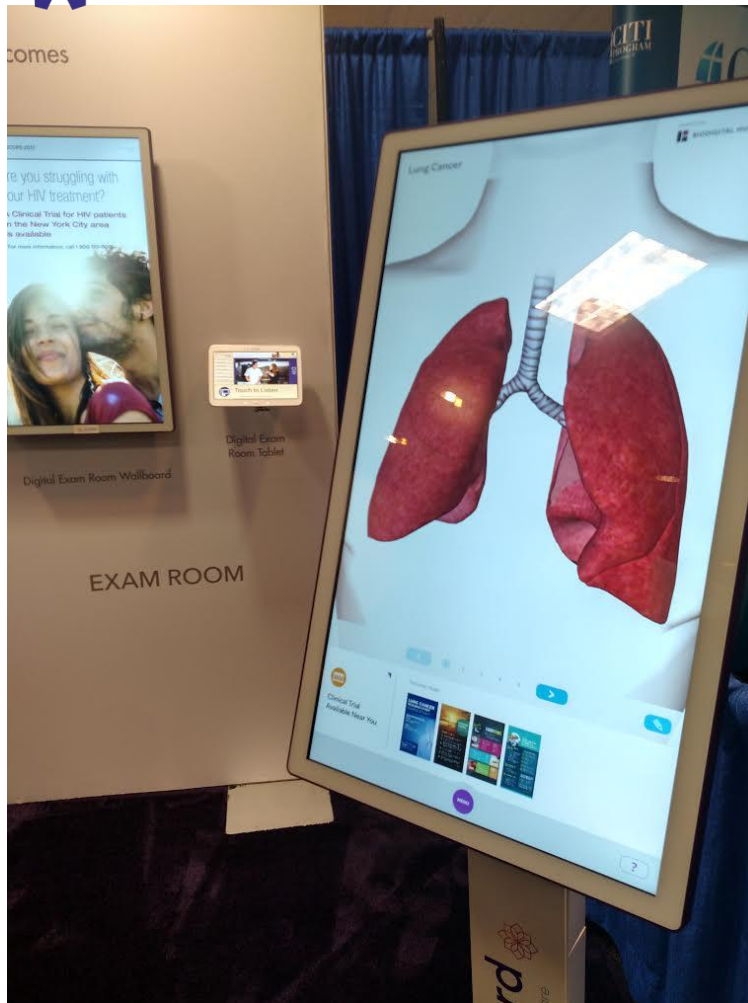
The redesigning of scanner must be attractive for the children.
