#### The Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights (PPVFR) Act, 2001

- •Enacted to protect plant varieties and the rights of farmers and plant breeders
- •Ensures benefit sharing and recognition of traditional farmers' contributions
- •Provides Farmers' Rights, Breeders' Rights, and Researchers' Rights







#### Key Features of the PPVFR Act

•Farmers' Rights: Right to save, use, exchange, and sell farm-saved seeds
•Breeders' Rights: Exclusive rights to produce, sell, and distribute registered plant varieties
•Researchers' Rights: Right to use protected varieties for research and

- •Researchers' Rights: Right to use protected varieties for research and breeding
- •Protection against biopiracy and unauthorized seed commercialization







**Eligibility and Implementation of PPVFR Act** 

Protection granted to new, extant, and farmers' varieties
Plant varieties must meet novelty, distinctiveness, uniformity, and stability (NDUS) criteria
Registration authority: Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority (PPVFRA)
